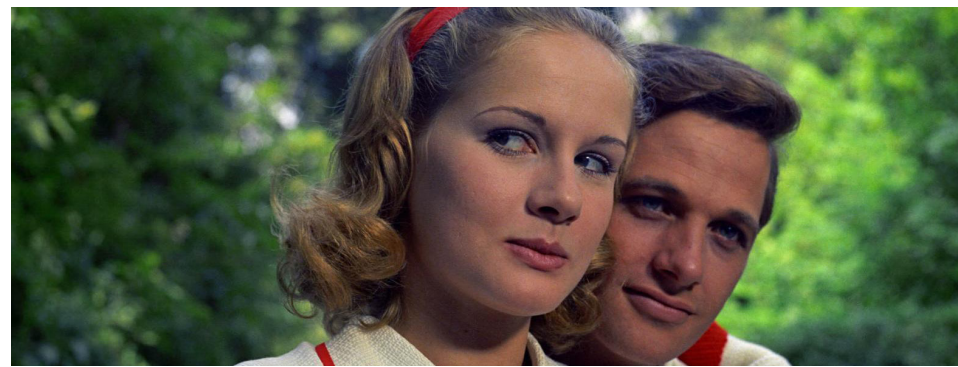

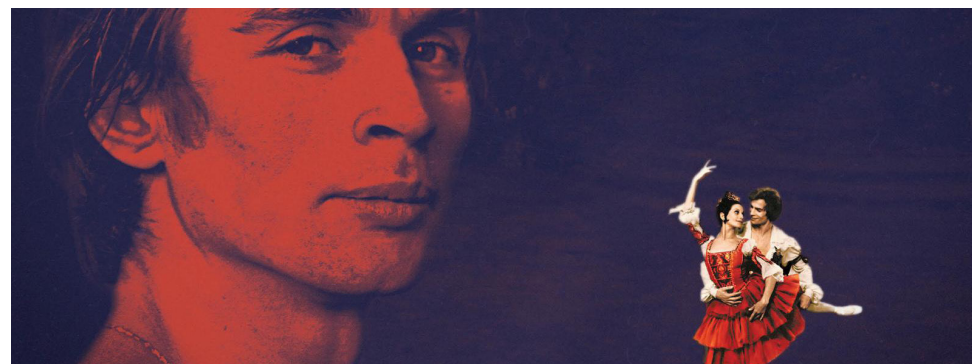

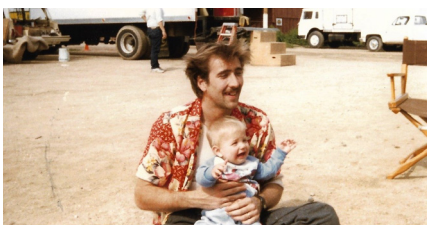

THE COOLIDGE AWARD HONORING RUTH E. CARTER

Sunday, October 15



The Coolidge is thrilled to announce legendary costume designer Ruth E. Carter as the next recipient of The Coolidge Award. For three decades, she has shaped the story of the Black experience on screen—from the '80s streetwear of *Do the Right Thing* to the royal regalia of *Coming 2 America*. Her work on Marvel's *Black Panther* and *Black Panther: Wakanda Forever* not only brought Afrofuturism to the mainstream, but also made her the first Black winner of an Oscar in costume design and the first Black woman to win two Academy Awards in any category.

In the weeks leading up to The Coolidge Award presentation, the Coolidge will also honor Ruth E. Carter and her costume design work with selected screenings from Carter's filmography, including *Black Panther* featuring a post-screening Q&A with Carter herself. See next page for details.
